The Military Officers Association of America is the largest military officer association in the nation. Founded in 1929, it is a non-profit organization with 400,000 members. The national headquarters is located in Alexandria, VA.

What is the Purpose of MOAA?

- * To promote the purposes and objectives of MOAA.
- * To foster fraternal relations among active, retired, and the reserve components as well as former officers of the uniformed services.
- * To protect the rights and interests of personnel of the uniformed services and their dependents and survivors.
- * To serve the community and the nation.

Jayhawk Chapter

The Jayhawk Chapter was organized in 1990 and affiliated with the national office of MOAA that same year. Today, more than 100 members in East Central Kansas belong to the chapter.

- Jayhawk Chapter is an active organization with bi-monthly dinner meetings, plus other activities, beginning in January. Since each meeting features an interesting program, your spouse and guests are invited to attend.
- Legislative matters concerning the military community are of vital interest to our members. We take an active role in working with Congress on issues concerning legislation for active and retired benefits and health care.
- Our chapter annually awards leadership medals and certificates to graduating Army, Navy and Air Force ROTC cadets and midshipman at the University of Kansas.
- You will receive our chapter newsletter, mailed prior to each meeting, January through November, as well as the annual membership directory.

Who is Eligible to Join?

Men and women who are or have been commissioned or warrant officers of the uniformed services (Army, Navy, Air Force, Marine Corps, Coast Guard, National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration and Public Health Service) or the Reserve Components of the services eligible. Auxiliary memberships are available for spouses of deceased members.

Kansas Council of Chapters

The Kansas Council of Chapters was organized in 1974 and allows MOAA chapters in Lawrence, Leavenworth, Manhattan, Overland Park, Salina, Topeka and Wichita to coordinate their efforts in the pursuit of common MOAA objectives.
